2. International Experiences	<ul> <li>Study Abroad: <ul> <li>3+ credit global focused courses, 10+ days (with related-to-class- content) of international travel &amp; a paper or project.</li> <li>A semester at an international institution with two or more checksheet-eligible engineering courses.</li> <li>International co-op or internship as defined above.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Other Options (if approved): <ul> <li>120 hrs of domestic service or research &amp; relevant 120+ hour international service or research experience.</li> <li>240+ hour international service or research experience</li> <li>Other proposed and approved experiences abroad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>*Rising sophomore abroad does NOT qualify</li> </ul>
3. Undergraduate Research	<ul><li>3+ credits OR</li><li>240 hours</li></ul>
4. Corps of Cadets	6-week experiences related to the student's future career
